Mid-State Technical College 4 AHS credit for every 1 MSTC credit

Students may register and pay for any evening MSTC course provided that the same (or similar) course is not offered at AHS. At the time of registration, students must submit MSTC course(s) name/information to the Assumption High School Academic Committee in order for course credit to be granted. The Academic Committee reserves the right to deny credit for any course lacking academic value.

Students will be granted ¼ AHS credit for every 1 MSTC credit successfully completed. Students, as in years past, will be required to write a 1-2 page paper about the course: positives, negatives, impressions of the course, comments about its content, and so on.

Typically, courses which fit AHS students' schedules are offered one evening per week, 2-4 hours per night; these courses are classified by MSTC as "adult/continuing education" classes. Adult/continuing education courses do not take the place of program/degree courses of the same number due to differences of time commitment, depth of material covered and number of credits. At the beginning of any MSTC course, students should indicate to their instructors that they wish to receive a letter grade upon completion of the course. AHS has a "7-class rule" which states that "all students at AHS must take 7 classes per semester" unless certain factors are present; a MSTC course does not count as one of these seven classes.
