Parking Rules/Regulation

1. All Students who drive a vehicle to school are **REQUIRED** to fill out the student parking form.
2. **Lock your vehicle.** Assumption High School will not accept responsibility for theft, damage, or vandalism to the vehicle or its contents.
3. Student must park only in areas designated in the Student Handbook.
4. Overnight parking is not allowed unless prior permission is granted by the principal.
5. Unsafe driving may result in a parent meeting and could be referred to law enforcement.
6. Assumption High School is a drug-free, chemical-free, and tobacco-free campus, including parking lots and vehicles parked on school property. Students are expected to fully comply with this policy.
7. Handicapped-accessible parking is available. Students requiring temporary or long-term accommodations should contact the school office.
8. Students who park on public streets are subject to municipal laws and must follow all applicable regulations.
