Dear Student:

The Portage County Health and Human Services Employee Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of a \$500 scholarship. The scholarship was established as a memorial to Dr. Gus Hangiandreou. Dr. Hangiandreou was the Psychological Services Director at the Portage County Health and Human Services Department until his passing in 1995.

ELIGIBILITY

Any full-time high school senior who has been accepted to a University, College, or Technical School, or any person currently attending or accepted to attend a University, College, or Technical School may apply. Applicants must be a resident of Portage County. Applicants must be majoring in or planning to major in one of the following fields: social work, sociology, psychology, human services, or psychiatry. Applicants must be enrolled or intending to enroll for a minimum of 6 credits per semester. PCHHS Employees' Foundation members and their immediate family are not eligible for this scholarship.

If you are a previous recipient of this scholarship, you are not eligible to apply.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Complete the application form for the scholarship and mail to the Foundation at the above address.
2. Submit two letters of reference.
3. Include a copy of your EFC/FAFSA information with your application.
4. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection of the recipients will be made by the Board of Directors based on community service, financial need, grade point average, letters of reference, and essay.

DEADLINE

All scholarship applications must be received by April 13, 2018.

Special Requirements:

The following selection criteria shall be utilized when reviewing applications and selecting recipients:

- Must not be a previous recipient of this scholarship.
- Must be a permanent Portage County resident.
- Must be pursuing a post-secondary degree in social work, sociology, psychology, human services, or psychiatry.
- Demonstrate academic success by having a minimum 2.75 GPA.
- Must include two letters of reference.

Financial need will be considered:

- Include a summary explaining your "Financial Need"
- You will need to apply for the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. It can be obtained by visiting www.fafsa.gov for more information. Once completed, you will receive both an **Expected Family Contribution (EFC)** code and also a **Student Aid Report (SAR)**. Please keep both for your records.
- Include a copy of your EFC/FAFSA report. Applicants who do not provide a copy of this report will not be considered.
