* Scholarship will be paid in two installments, directly to the student's institution. \$500 each semester.

Deadline: Applications must be received by no later than **March 1st, 2018**

Criteria to Apply for the Scholarship

Qualifications

- Applicants must be accepted at an accredited undergraduate institution in the US and be enrolled full-time.
- Pursuing a bachelor's degree for the first time.
- A senior in high school. Special consideration will be given to students attending Almond-Bancroft, Tri-County, or Assumption High School.

Academic Achievement

- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Be enrolled in a demanding course of study

Financial Need (qualifying applicants should have one or more of the following)

- A part time job
- Special financial circumstances
- Low expected family contribution

Characteristics (strong applicants would)

- Demonstrate leadership characteristics
- Exhibit grit when faced with hardship
- Demonstrate a desire to make a meaningful contribution to society both present and future.
- Be involved in a balance of community, school and work activities.

Submit the following documents with this application. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

1. Completed H. James Kollock Scholarship Application (attached)
2. Your current transcript showing courses AND current GPA.
3. A typed essay containing no more than 500 words describing your most meaningful achievements, your future goals, your intended field of study (if decided), and why you would be a good candidate to receive this award.
4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher, or school administrator. *Must be on school letterhead.
5. A photo of applicant.
