

Senior Year Checklist for College Applications

1. Review your list of universities or technical colleges. The Counseling Office encourages all applications to be completed by October 31st.
2. You should have visited the colleges you are planning on applying to. If you have not, this should be done prior to your final decision on the school you will be attending.
3. Most colleges use online applications which should be located on their webpage. All University of Wisconsin applications can be found at <https://apply.wisconsin.edu>
4. College essays/personal statements are important; write a draft and have someone with English skills evaluate it. Clear, concise writing is important.
5. Request letters of recommendation early - give your writer at least two weeks to write the letter. Pick up the Letter of Recommendation forms in the Counseling Office and take to the person you are asking the recommendation from.
6. Immediately notify the Counseling Office when you are applying to any post-secondary schools so that all transcripts can be sent out in a timely manner.
