From the desk of Father Levi Schmitt

I delayed thinking about my post-high-school plans until February or March of my senior year. It has been a pleasant surprise to find that other people have sharper prioritizing skills than I do. A couple of Assumption seniors that I have come across have already started exploring colleges and even submitting applications. There is a fair bit of pressure that comes with a decision of this magnitude. Granted, the field you study in college or the skill you hone at a tech school do not necessarily lock you in for life, but they are not small things either. Fortunately, that decision is not entirely on us—at least not if we let God have a say. Cardinal John Henry Newman offers a brief reflection on this point in his *Meditations and Devotions*:

God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons.

God has a unique plan for each of our lives; a unique set of people that He wants us to engage. So, open up a conversation with God about those major life-decisions. Whatever plan God has for you, it will be incredibly good! And hey, remember, too, that God might happen to have that same invitation for you that we hear in this Sunday's Gospel, "you, too, go and work in the vineyard."
