## In Person Remote Learning

The administration of Assumption Catholic Schools understands and recognizes that there will be times when students will miss extended periods of school due to illness, or when they are monitoring COVID-19 symptoms at home. For students who are face to face learners, the remote option can be a valuable tool in keeping up with their academics if they will be missing multiple days of school. Remote learning is designed for those students whose families truly demonstrate a need for this option, and is not intended for students who do not wish to attend school on a particular day or week. How and when a student joins remotely can vary depending on grade level, but for Assumption Middle School and High School the following guidelines have been put in place:

### 1. If my child is sick, when should they join remotely?

In person learners will NOT join remotely unless they have been, or will be gone from school for **more than 3 school days**. During their absence from school, and if their health allows, students will still be expected to log into Google Classroom keeping up with daily assignments as best they can until their return.

### 2. How and when do parents notify the school when their child will be missing 4 or more days of school due to illness?

For students who have been or will be missing more than 3 days in a row due to illness or symptom monitoring, the parents should contact the school via phone call or email and request remote learning. Remote learning requests must be made 24 hours in advance so teachers have time to prepare the Google Meet Invite.

### 3. When my student is remote, what are the expectations?

- Remote learners are expected to be present and engaged in each digital class time/period as if he/she was physically present in the room. Teachers will have a digital link open during the class time. Depending on the nature of the lesson, students may not have to be logged on the whole time.
- All assignments will be completed following the same time table as the physical class.
- Staff will be available for 1:1 chat or email daily to answer further questions (safe environment rules will be in place).
- Attendance and truancy rules/laws will apply as outlined in the handbook.
- The standard ACS grading scale and policies will be used as outlined in the handbook.
- Academic integrity policies will be in place per handbook and building.
- In the event the student is too ill to participate in lessons that day, the parent must contact the school office to report the absence, as they would normally do, had the student been attending in person classes per school policy.
