39th Annual Royal Event

After much deliberation, we've made the difficult decision to cancel Royal Event in 2020 due to COVID-19. <u>I'm attaching a letter</u> that was sent to our prior years' sponsors, craft vendors, and food booth reps at the parishes. Similar communication was also sent to our ACS families and published on Facebook a couple weeks back. The response has been supportive. Our constituents realize this wasn't an easy decision to make, but it was the right decision for the health and safety of our students, faculty, families, and friends of Assumption.

9th Annual Auction Royale

Auction Royale was originally scheduled for Saturday, November 7th of 2020, but will now be postponed to March of 2021 - again due to COVID-19. Details to follow as planning begins...

2020-2021 Annual Appeal - November 2020

Work has begun slightly earlier this year on the messaging and branding for the Royal Fund Annual Appeal, which is slated to be delivered in early November. In addition, Linda and Dan are strategizing the concept of a COVID-19 appeal (similar to the Roof Fund appeal in 2019) and how we could best align this opportunity for giving in advance of our typical Annual Appeal ask.

We understand that our local businesses and community members are hurting too. Therefore, in light of the cancellation, we are not asking for your monetary and product donations in support of Royal Event this year. But we do ask for your prayers and we simply want to take this opportunity to thank you - for supporting us in the past and for standing by us today in this difficult decision. We remain committed to celebrating our mission and building our vision together as one school community moving forward. We'll share additional details on our plans for next year's Royal Event as they become available. In the meantime, thanks for your patience and understanding - and we look forward to welcoming our Royal Event supporters back in September of 2021! When the time comes, we do hope you'll remember Assumption Catholic Schools in your giving plans. Until then, stay healthy and God Bless!
