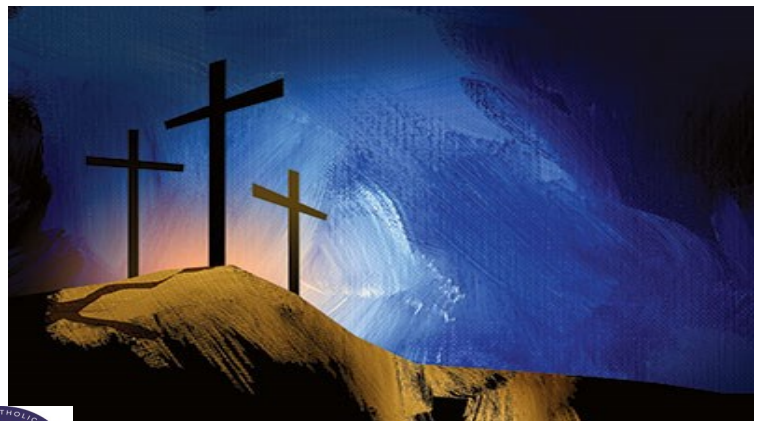

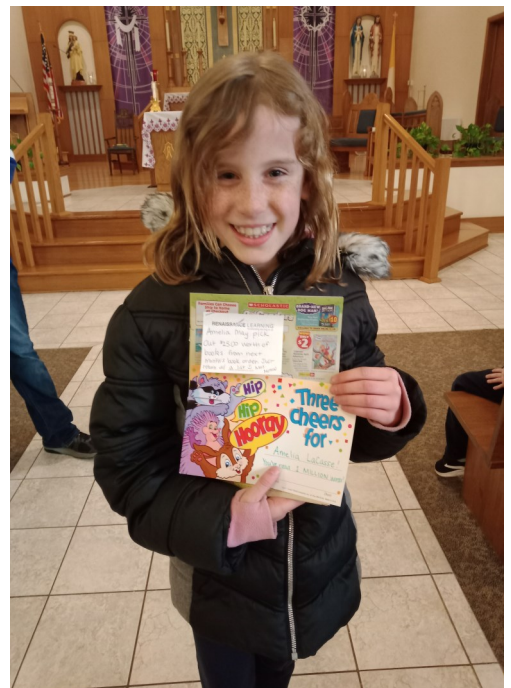
*Every Friday afternoon during Lent, the students were able to celebrate the Stations of the Cross.*

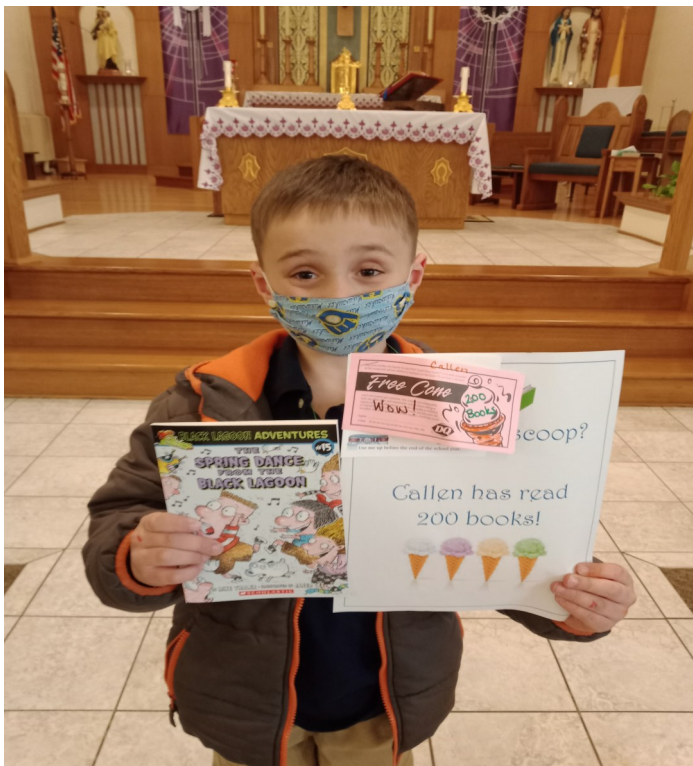

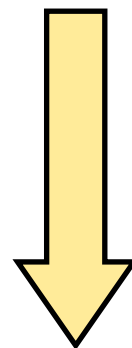
