

# CHROMEBOOK RETURN

## CHROMEBOOK RETURN DATE

Students should return their Chromebook AND charging cable to their homeroom teacher.

All Chromebooks will be checked over for damage.

(remote students: return date–May 27)

Per the signed Chromebook Agreement that each student signed before they were given a Chromebook states:

Students/Families will be held financially responsible for loss or any damage to their Chromebook.

Replacement cost for a lost Chromebook is \$200.00

Cost of repair to damaged Chromebooks can vary and will be determined after inspection.



Mrs. Baker gave her six graders a choice to participate in Solo and Ensemble this year. Solo and Ensemble is an opportunity for students to perform in front of a professional judge (and their peers in a "normal" non-COVID situation) and receive feedback. Students are given a level of difficulty by choosing either class C~beginner, class B~intermediate or class A~advanced. Then a professional singing judge will rate their performance by giving either a first (the best), second (pretty good), or third (needs improvement) based on the quality of their performance but they do not compete against other students.

The following 4 students: Lyla Fisher, Sabina Hellmich, Bellarose Roth and Callie Schoenick, volunteered their time after school to practice a solo for Solo and Ensemble with Mrs. Baker and they **ALL RECEIVED A 1ST RATING** on their class C performances!!! **Way to GO!!!**

The students prepare by picking a song they are drawn to and fits their voice range, and then memorize it. On top of that, they introduce themselves and the accompanist, tell what school they attend, recite the title and composer name as well as a significant aspect of the selection (style, form, harmony, melody, rhythm or technique).


