As you know, trying to motivate students to do homework is not always easy.

Over the past two Hexes we have seen an increase in missing work.

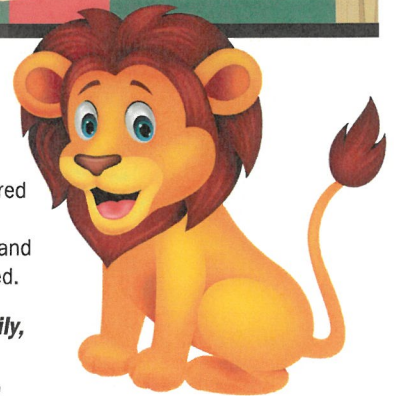
