- WPCP(Wisconsin Parental Choice Program) application window is February 1st-April 20th, 2023
 Current WPCP families will need to login to http://dpi.wi.gov/choice to re-apply. Proof of Residency must be presented to the Advancement Office.
- Mr. Minter has been working with School Choice Wisconsin to increase WPCP entry points, application windows, and voucher funds. There will be a series of youtube videos that will touch on these points that are being produced by School Choice Wisconsin.
- Applying for Tuition Assistance/Financial Aid continues to be an online application through FACTS/Ren Web.
- Scholarship forms can be found on the ACS website. Anyone can apply for a scholarship.
 Scholarship forms are due to the Finance Office by April 17th.
- Testing Information/Student assessments include:
 - K-12 STAR Math, Reading, and Early Literacy.

 - Forward Exam-Choice students grades 3-8, 10
