## Wisconsin Rapids Parks & Recreation



The Wisconsin Rapids Swim Club (WRSC) is a competitive swim team that is a new Wisconsin Rapids Parks and Recreation program. Swimmers from Wisconsin Rapids and surrounding communities are welcome to join. The regular competitive season runs from the last week of November through the first week of February, with practices beginning on October 23. Swim meets will be held on weekends throughout Northern Wisconsin.

**Practices** (Lincoln High School Natatorium, 1801 16<sup>th</sup> St S)  
Mondays & Fridays, 6-8 p.m., Tuesdays, 7:30-9 p.m.  
Younger swimmers may have shorter practice times.

**Suggested Equipment:** Swim cap & goggles, fins, kickboard, hand paddles, pull buoy, water bottle

**Prerequisites:** Swimmers ages 5-18 (through senior in high school) must pass Level 5 Red Cross Swimming Level or have the ability to swim 25 yards Freestyle non-stop.
