Enjoy the weekend with friends and family. Stay safe, stay healthy, and stay kind.

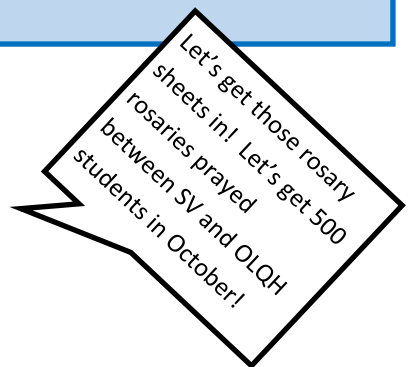

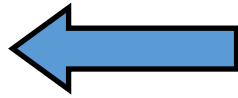

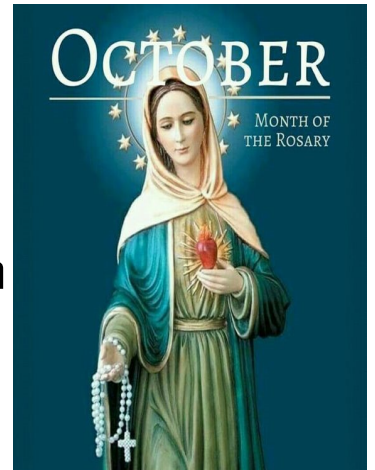
