Suggested Equipment: Swim cap & goggles, fins, kickboard, hand paddles, pull buoy, water bottle

Prerequisites: Swimmers ages 5-18 (through senior in high school) must pass Level 5 Red Cross Swimming Level or have the ability to swim 25 yards Freestyle non-stop.
