The Miracle and Message of Fatima

An opportunity to learn about the Fatima Message for our times and devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Barb Ernster, national coordinator for the World Apostolate of Fatima/Our Lady's Blue Army, will be giving a presentation on the message of Fatima, especially relevant for our times, and the importance of the Devotion to the Immaculate Heart, as the Blessed Mother announced at Fatima in 1917.

Barb will present the story, the miracles and the message—a message of hope and peace for our hearts, our homes and a world in need—with photos and stories from Fatima and the three children, who reached the highest levels of true devotion to Jesus through Mary.

Our Lady of Fatima told the three children on July 13, 1917, "If what I tell you is heeded, many souls will be saved and there will be peace." She requested the prayer of the Rosary daily, "especially in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary, because only she can help you."

The Blessed Virgin Mother came from Heaven to show us the pathway to God, through her Immaculate Heart. Her invitation extends to all her children, for all time. It is known as the Peace Plan from Heaven.
