Golden Mass

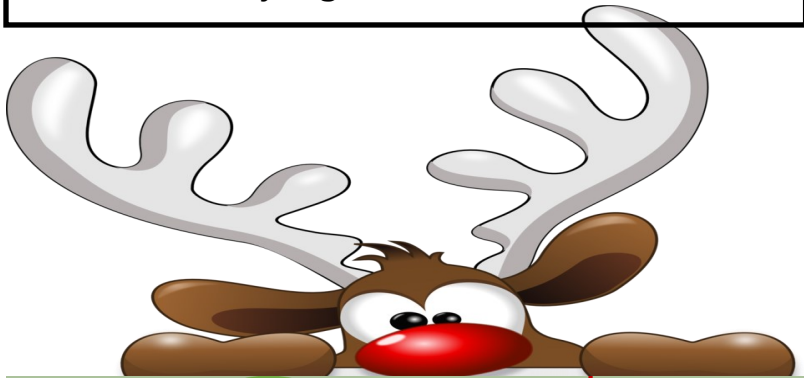

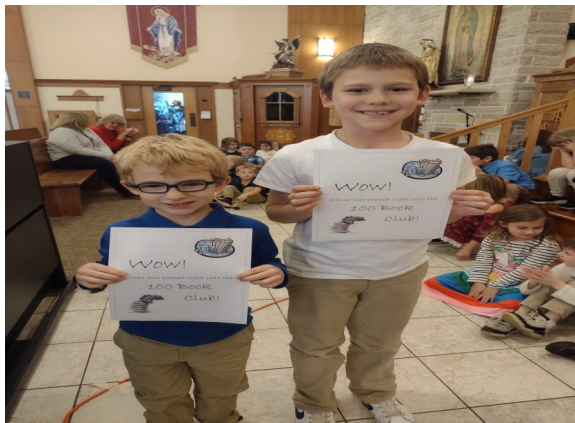
Our December and June birthday students enjoyed a special birthday breakfast with Mrs. Bruley.
