SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA – 2024

____ GSHBA Scholarship of Excellence - \$1,500

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any eligible student or resident seeking education in the building industry living in GSHBA tri-county area of Adams, Juneau, Portage, Waushara, Waupaca, and Wood counties. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

____ Jeff Nygaard Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000

GSHBA sponsors this \$500 scholarship in memory of former member Jeff Nygaard. This scholarship will be available to any student or resident in the Portage County area seeking an education in the health care profession or building related industry. This "stipend" will be granted directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment.

____ The Portage County Bank Scholarship - \$1,000

The Portage County Bank sponsors this \$1,000 scholarship. This scholarship will be available to any student or resident in the Portage County area that is seeking education in the finance/banking profession or building industry. This "stipend" will be granted directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment.

____ The GSHBA Winner Winner Chicken Dinner Scholarship - \$1,000

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any eligible student or resident that is affiliated with a Golden Sands Home Builders Association, family, or friend, seeking to further their education outside of high school. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

____ Ryley Hofferber Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000 (2)

Two of these scholarships will be available, for \$1,000 each. This is available to a student from Portage or Waupaca County. The award recipient must be planning on entering or enrolled in a degree apprenticeship program or education program in the field of building construction trades. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

____ Hammer Down Scholarship - \$1,000

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any student seeking education in the Building Industry, Health/Promotional Wellenes or Physical Therapy living in Adams, Juneau, Portage, Waushara, Waupaca or Wood County. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

____ GSHBA Parade of Homes Scholarship - \$1,000

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any student seeking education in the Building Industry, Interior Design, Drafting or Marketing fields living in Adams, Juneau, Portage, Waushara, Waupaca or Wood County. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

_____ **Point Masonry Mitchell A. Bacher Memorial - \$1,000**

This scholarship is available to any student or resident pursuing the building construction trades or the arts living in Portage County. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient.

_____ **Alchemy Concrete Scholarship - \$1,000**

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to a student from Amherst High School. The award recipient must be planning on entering or enrolled in a degree apprenticeship program or education program in the field of building construction trades. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

_____ **Wayne Bushman Scholarship - \$1,000**

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any new or continuing full or part time student seeking education at Mid-State Technical College in the Construction Trades program. The “stipend” will be granted directly to the recipient’s school upon verification of enrollment.

_____ **Freedom Home Builders Scholarship - \$1,000**

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Must have an enlistment contract to join any branch of service.
2. Must be in one of the trades or joining an engineer MOS.

Can be a split opening they already did basic training, and they are home to finish high school before going to do second phase of initial entry training.

_____ **Marty Family Scholarship - \$1,000**

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to any student or resident in the Portage County area that is seeking education in General Construction, Business or Finance. This "stipend" will be granted directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment.

_____ **Eric Walters Memorial Scholarship – Milwaukee pack out, Milwaukee tools, Work Boot Voucher (Value of \$1,500)**

This scholarship is available to any student in the GSHBA tri-county area of Adams, Juneau, Portage, Waushara, Waupaca, and Wood counties that is enrolled in a degree apprenticeship program or education program in the field of building construction trades. With verification of acceptance and enrollment into an apprenticeship program the scholarship supplies will be given to the student at the awards banquet.

Confine your information to the application.
6. Attached with this application your most current, complete school transcript showing your classes taken, GPA and class rank.
7. Attach a maximum of 2 letters of recommendation, of which not more than one is from a current or past teacher. If letters of recommendation are coming in separate, please inform us. The deadline for the recommendations letter is also **March 29th, 2024**.
8. The successful applicant must be a permanent resident of the central Wisconsin area.
9. Preference will be given to family members of the GSHBA membership.

Successful applicants will be notified in **April 2024**, and will be invited, along with their parents, to attend a Golden Sands Home Builders Association dinner in April to accept their scholarship.
