December was a busy month in our music classroom! The students worked very hard on their Christmas concert music and the concert was a huge success! The students were fantastic! We spent the rest of the month enjoying Christmas-themed music activities. The students did rhythmic and steady beat play-alongs, sing-alongs, and movement activities to some familiar Christmas songs, as well as play fun games like Movie Music Bingo.

Our composer of the month was Tchaikovsky. We had fun listening to music from "The Nutcracker." The second graders also got to explore a "Nutcracker" virtual room and watched various excerpts from the ballet.
