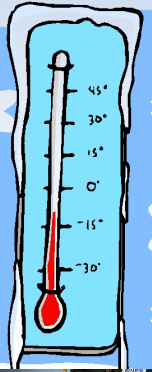
Joey L. will try out the principal position. He chose the opportunity after reading over a million words.

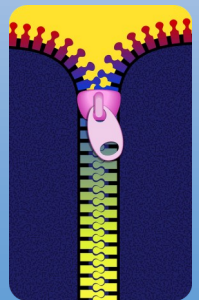

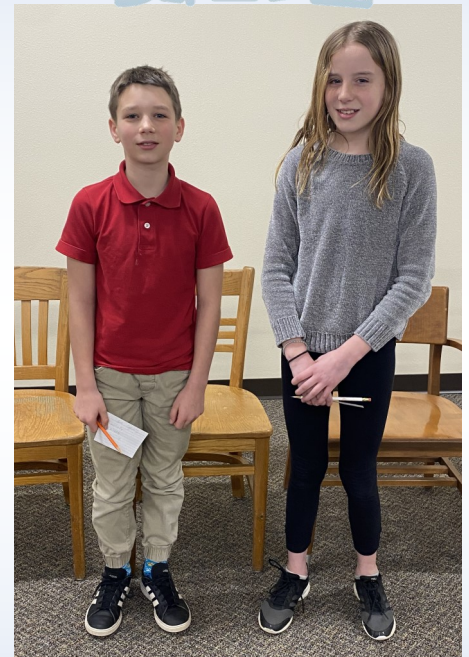

Amelia will advance to WRAMS next week. If she is unable to attend, Rogan will be representing SVDP.

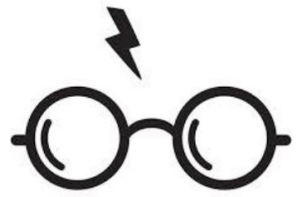

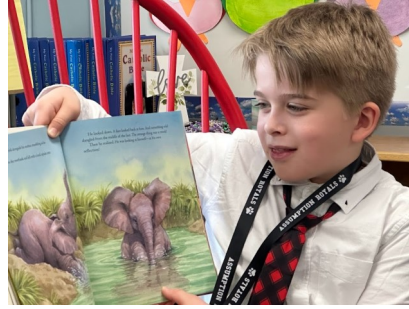
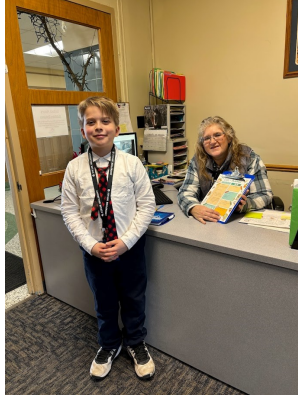


FROM THE DESK OF Mr. Joey L.

The 3rd graders needed me to read to them. They were good listeners. Thank you for your time.

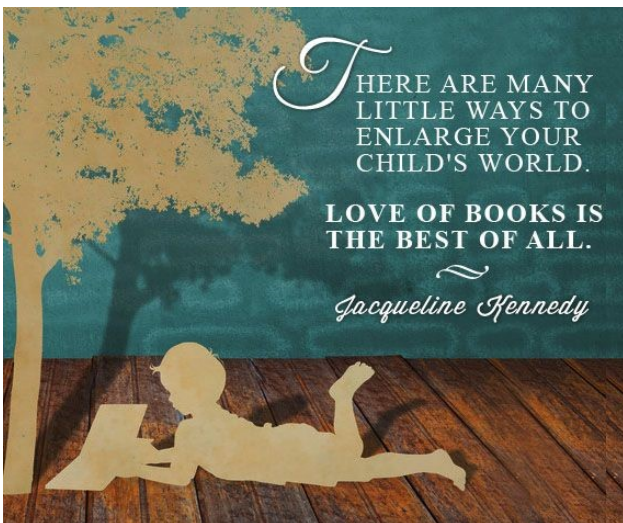
