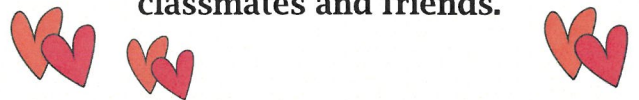

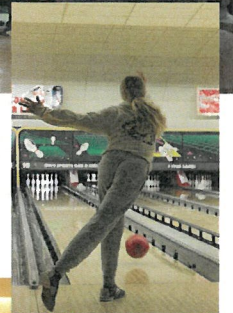

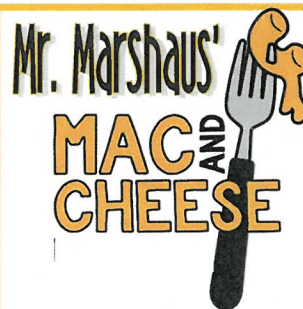

Solo and Ensemble Band & Choir Info--2024



WHAT, WHEN, WHERE AND WHO:

On **FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024**, the Assumption High School and Assumption Middle School band and choir students will be participating in the **District Solo and Ensemble Festival**. Assumption is hosting this event and will include band and choir students from Columbus HS/MS, Newman HS/MS, Auburndale HS/JHS, Edgar HS/MS, in addition to the Assumption HS/MS music students.

- This is a **REQUIRED EVENT** for **ALL of the High School and Middle School BAND and CHOIR members**
- Students are reminded that this is still a school day, so all school rules and policies still apply. This includes rules for cell phones.

DRESS CODE:

Please remember that this is a dress-up event. Girls are to wear a skirt, dress, or nice pants, and boys are to wear a shirt and tie. **Jeans, t-shirts, sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, Royal wear shirts, sweatshirts, etc. are NOT ALLOWED** for solo and ensemble. We are representing our school, and we want to project the best possible image. Students are to be dressed up for the **entire day**, not just for the time they perform.

EVENT TIMES:

This music event begins at 8:00 A.M. and ends around 4:00 P.M. Students have been preparing solos and ensembles, which they will perform for a judge, and then receive a rating or a critique. Each student or group of students has been assigned a specific time or times throughout the day to perform. The schedule of the individual music events for middle school as well as a map of the sites, is included in the Friday Folder information. The important parts of the schedule are the **SITE#** (room performing in), **TIME, STUDENT NAME** (who is performing), **VOICE/INST** (what kind of event it is), and **ACCOMPANIST/PARTICIPANTS** (who is involved in the instrumental ensembles). There is a separate list in Friday Folder information of who is in each vocal event. Many events will not be finished by 2:45, so please plan accordingly for transportation at the end of the day.

SCHOOL DAY TIME REQUIREMENTS:

Since the music students' events are assigned at various times throughout the day, and there will be no regular classes happening that day, there is a modified school time requirement for all music students on Friday, February 16, 2024. **ALL High School and Middle School music students** must be at school a **MINIMUM of 4 hours** on Solo and Ensemble day for this to count as a school day, and to have adequate time to complete their music assignment. **ALL High School and Middle School music students** must **SIGN-IN** at the time of their arrival at the SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT table in the High School Front Lobby or at the SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT table by the back door of the GYM. ALL music students must also **SIGN-OUT** when they are exiting the building. MIDDLE SCHOOL MUSIC STUDENTS must be signed out by a parent/guardian if they will be leaving before the official end of the school day (2:45). Middle School music students may not leave the Assumption campus on their own at any point during the school day. **REGARDLESS OF THE TIME STUDENTS LEAVE, EVERYONE MUST SIGN OUT** at the Sign-In/Sign-Out table in the High School front lobby.

MUSIC ASSIGNMENT REQUIREMENTS:

Because this a musical learning experience, all Assumption music participants will pick up an assignment packet in the high school front lobby at the time of their arrival on Solo & Ensemble day. This packet must be completed and turned in to the "Assumption Packet Return" box in the high school front lobby before the students leave Assumption at the end of the day. This assignment will be an automatic zero if it is not completed and returned on Solo and Ensemble day.

CONCESSIONS AVAILABLE:

There will be no regular school lunch served on solo and ensemble day. There will be items for sale at the concession stand for breakfast and lunch, or students may bring a sack lunch. A copy of the concession offerings is included in the Friday Folder information

AUDIENCE ATTENDANCE:

This event is free and open to the public. Parents, relatives, etc. are invited and encouraged to attend this event and support our music students.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:

We are still in need of volunteers for the 12:00-2:00 and the 2:00-4:00 shifts in the concession stand. If you or someone you know can help, please email Renee Kollock at rkollock@assumptioncatholicschools.org.

PREPARATION:

If you have not already done so, please ask your child to play/sing his or her song for you. Many students are participating in multiple events; therefore, they have many different songs to practice. The more practice the students get playing/singing in front of people, the better they will perform. The students should be practicing their pieces at least every other day until February 16th. Practicing just once a week is not nearly enough time to adequately prepare, so please encourage your child to practice frequently in this next week.

Students who have not prepared adequately will not be allowed to perform, and will need to reimburse the school for the entry fee. The fees range from \$10.00-\$25.00. This is meant to be a positive experience for all of the students, and we would not want any student to perform who was not prepared to do so!!

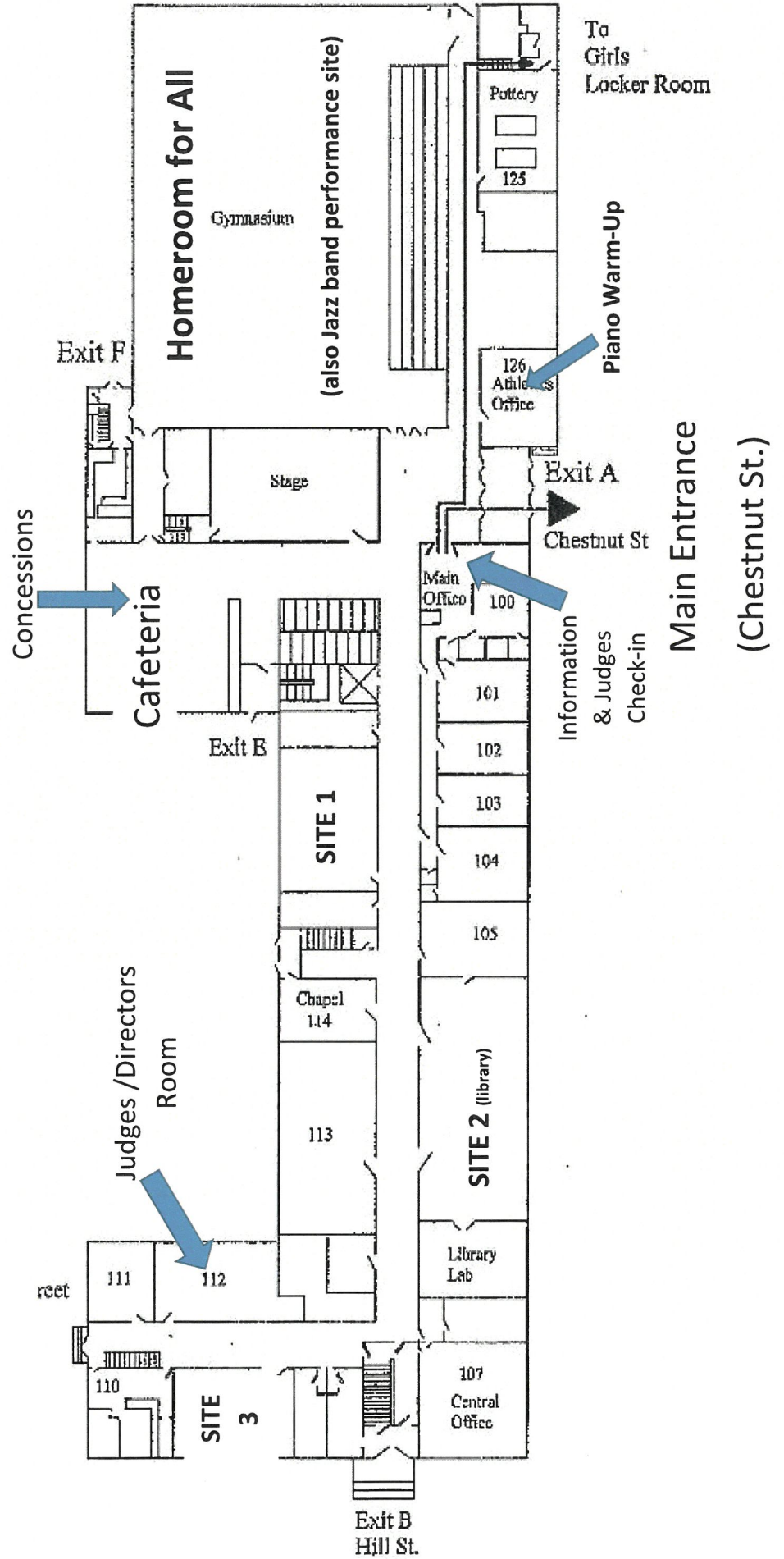

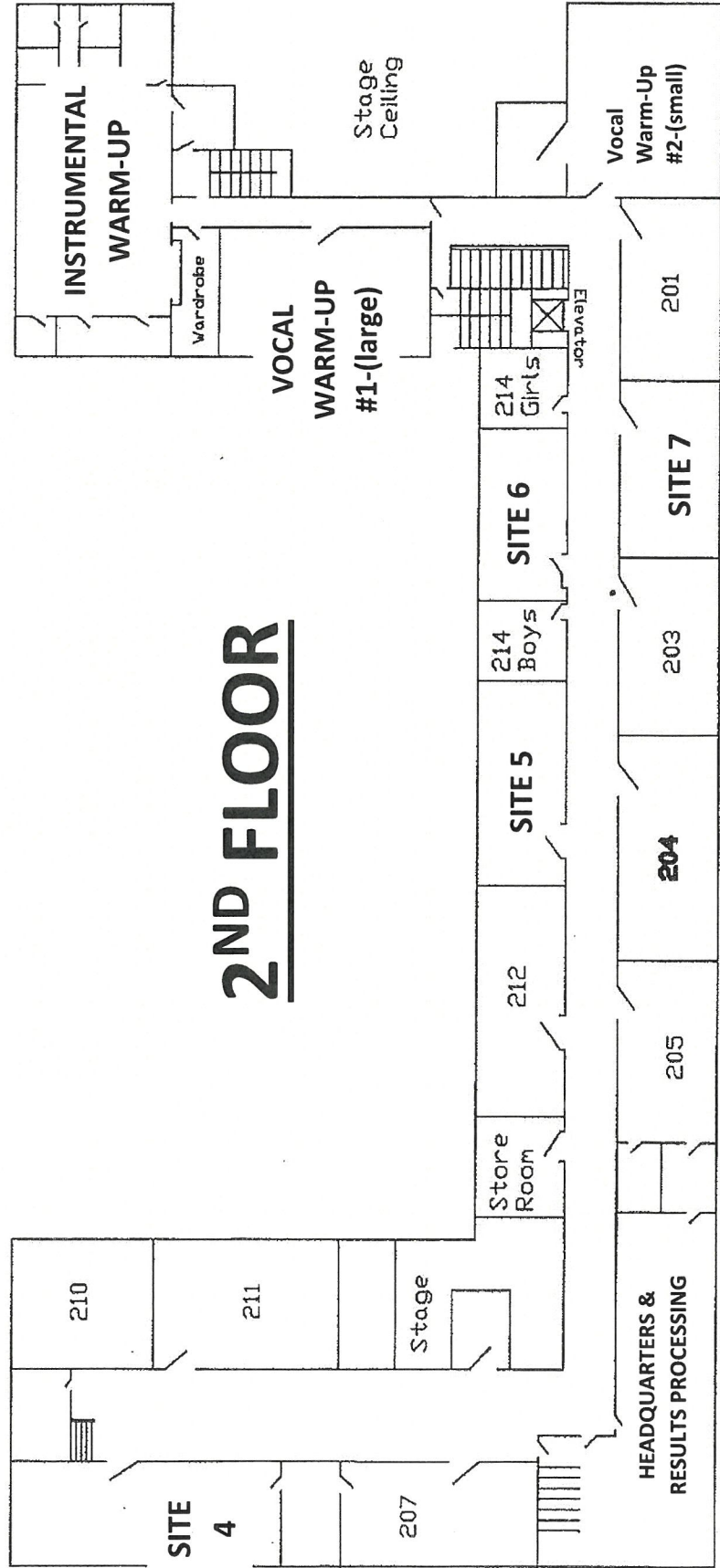

Per State requirement, Assumption Catholic Schools holds two Board of Directors meetings per year. The purpose is to inform parents on the State of the Schools, provide updates to parents, and answer parent questions.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Minter at 4:30 pm.

Fr. Guanella led an opening prayer.

- Kerry Meinel gave an update on enrollment and the required 2nd Friday in January Count Date. There are two required count dates per year. The 3rd Friday in September and the 2nd Friday in January. This year, the 2nd Friday in January was actually a snow day, so attendance was taken before and after the count date. The count included 432 total students in grades K-12, 183 WPCP participants, and 31 SNSP participants.
- Enrollment/Re-Enrollment has begun for ACS and the WPCP program. The last day to apply for WPCP is April 18th. The last day to get ACS Scholarship forms into Mrs. Meinel is April 19th.
- In regards to how Choice Vouchers are given...For the 2024-25 school year, state law mandates that no more than 9% of student membership of a public school district may participate in the WPCP. The DPI does a random drawing. If more seats become available due to students that decline the voucher or later withdraw from their school, the DPI will fill the available seats from the waiting list.
- Spring Assessment dates are attached.
- Volunteer hours and fundraising – Events such as concessions at games and Solo and Ensemble cannot occur without the help of many. ACS does ask parents and students to volunteer at various school events. No punishment will occur if a family does not volunteer. Assistance is greatly appreciated at these events.
- For specific questions regarding WPCP or SNSP please contact Mrs. Meinel.

- Thank you to everyone who completed the survey that went out. We are in the process of looking over the responses with the administrative team and the Education Commission and will follow up with results soon.

The Next Board of Directors Meeting will be in the Fall of 2024.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:05 pm.
