

OLQH Music Beat

February 2024



January was a fun-filled month for music class. Throughout this month, students learned about Johann Sebastian Bach and explored his life and music. They learned about the pipe organ and that Bach was a virtuoso musician. We did some movement exercises to his music as well as play-alongs with instruments. The second graders got to watch the movie "Mr. Bach Comes to Call" and learned more about his life and music. Students learned that some of Bach's music is used in the hymns we sing in church! He was a very interesting composer to study!

This past month, the second graders explored playing on mallet instruments. We will do more with that in the coming months. They really enjoyed it! Recently we celebrated the 100th day of school. The second graders composed their own 100-beat rhythms and played them! They are getting better and better at reading and playing rhythms!

The first graders explored music through different tempos, made a class booklet of the song "Miss Lucy," and had their first class with centers. Through the centers, they matched words to rhythms, listened to Bach's "Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring," and composed their own melodies on boomwhackers. We enjoy listening to each student's melody!

The kindergartners have been learning about telling stories through music. We've read "The Little Engine that Could" and talked about tempo. We also read the story "Sleeping Beauty" and sang along.

Throughout February, students will explore the music of Sergei Prokofiev. This is one of my favorite units to teach because they will get to listen to the music and story of "Peter and the Wolf!" This music is a wonderful example of theme in music and a great way to introduce the instruments of the orchestra.
