Scholarship Application

The Wood County Association for Home & Community Education (HCE) will award a \$500 scholarship, in memory of Marge Klumb and Iola Woods, to a high school senior residing in Wood County and attending a Wood County high school or being home schooled in Wood County.

The scholarship is available to any graduating senior who will be enrolling in higher education at a technical school, college, or university. Selection process includes a face-to-face interview with the top three applicants.

Through applications and the interview, the Wood County HCE Scholarship Committee will determine who is to receive the award and the recipient will be notified by the end of May 2024. The \$500 scholarship will be paid to the recipient after the first semester of college if the recipient's grades are "C" average or above.

Please make a copy of this Wood County HCE Application Packet for each student wishing to apply for the scholarship.

The completed application packet must include:

- Application Form
- Essay outlining education and career goals (200 words or less)
- Principal or Guidance Counselor Form
- Three recommendation forms with letters of recommendation

Please include **one** recommendation from **each** of the categories listed below:

- 1. School: teacher, coach, or counselor not school principal
- 2. Community/Civic: youth organization leader, clergy
- 3. Work/Personal: employer, neighbor, family friend no relatives

Note: All letters of recommendation must be included with application.
