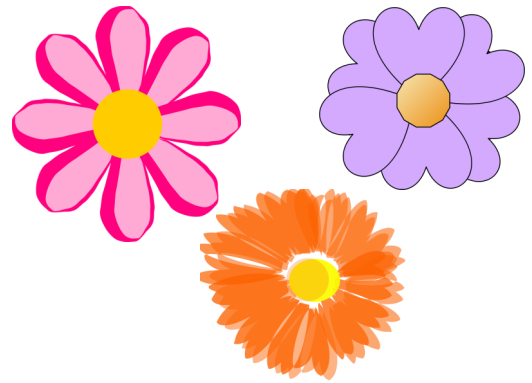

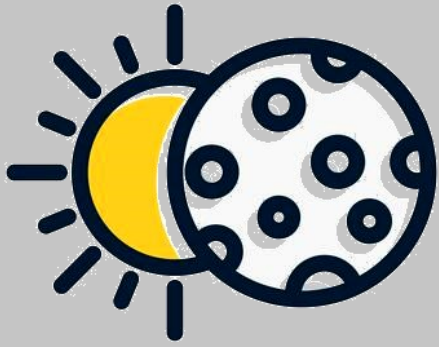


OLQH Music Beat
