On February 15<sup>th</sup>, Mrs. Baker took Addie Cusack, Kendall Duellman, Kara Drewiski, Evan Harris, Alex Jacoby, Brad Jorgensen, and Manny Schultz to compete in the 5<sup>th</sup> annual Wisconsin Rapids Regional Tournament Finance and Investment Challenge Bowl hosted by Mid-State Technical College. Asset Builders, a non-profit organization with a mission of increasing financial literacy, has teamed up with South Wood County Financial Stability Coalition. The United Way's Financial Stability Coalition's goal is that community members learn skills to become financially independent. As the picture reflects, there are many community sponsors in our area!

The FICB is a financial literacy program for high school students that aligns with Wisconsin's Model Academic Standards for Personal Finance and Economics, and the Jumpstart National Standards. The FICB culminated in a live, college-bowl tournament where teams compete to determine regional champions. Teams that finish in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each region then advance to the state championship tournament, which will be held in May.

The FICB content is "all about" finance – there is no content from other subjects. They "come to you" by hosting live tournaments around the state. Our in-person interactive format, with students playing through a series of games in a tournament setting, is an effective learning strategy that reinforces lessons already being taught in the classroom and celebrates student achievement in an atmosphere of friendly competition. The best evidence of the value teachers see in the FICB is the fact that the program is growing and almost all teachers bring students to the tournaments year-after-year!

This year Wisconsin Rapids Lincoln brought-8 teams, SPASH-2, Iola-Scandinavia-3, Amherst-5, Pittsvile-1, Tri-County-3, and Assumption High School brought 2 this year.

Mrs. Baker is extremely proud and blessed to have had some hardworking students to represent Assumption! We placed 10<sup>th</sup> out of 24<sup>!</sup> Considering we are a small school compared to our counterpart public schools, we all should be very proud!
