K-5 LITERACY NIGHT-FAMILY GAME NIGHT!



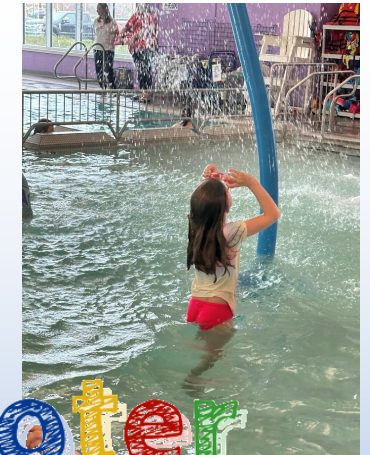
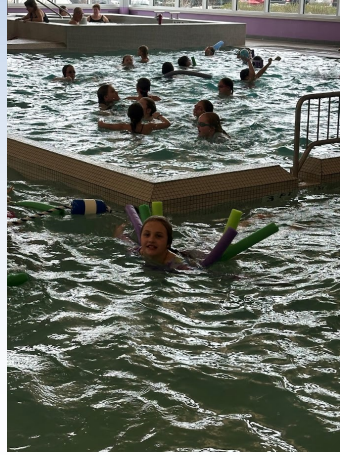

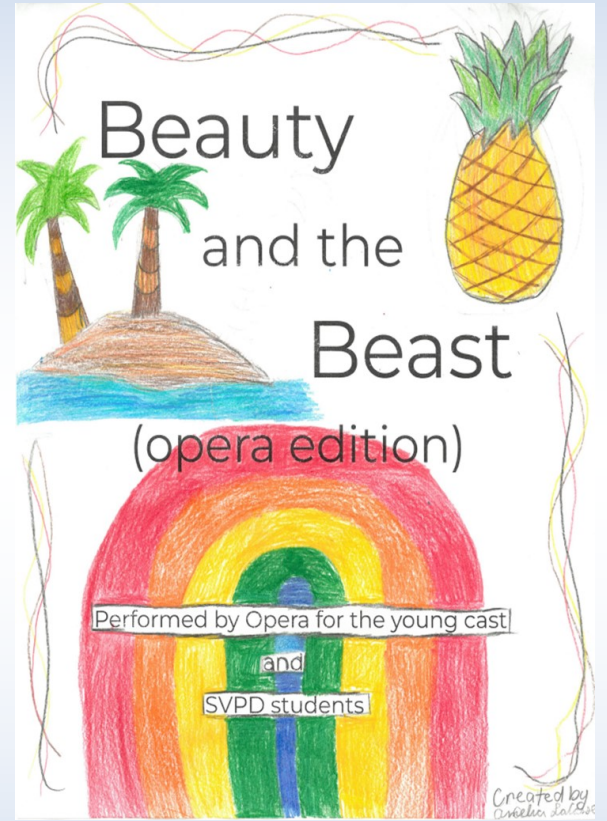
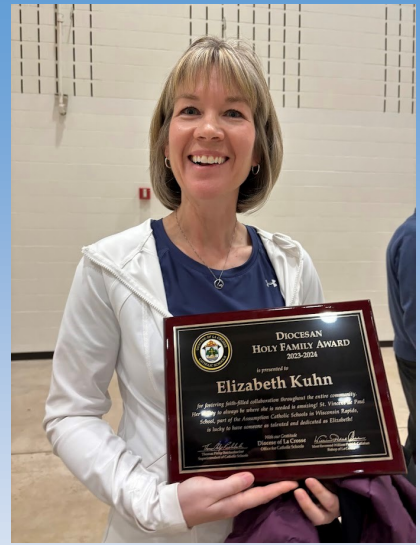
CONGRATULATIONS, MRS. KUHN
