

Congratulations to our Math Team for taking home their **7th consecutive title!!!** The Central Wisconsin Math League is in its 54th year and is run out of UWSP's math department. There were around 50 schools from all over the state that competed this year. Students are tested in 3 divisions throughout the year and accumulate points based on their performance on these rigorous tests. Individual awards went to the following:

Students in the Intro to AutoCAD class participated in a drone demonstration where Mike Johnson, Civil Engineering instructor at Mid-State Technical College, used an automated flight planning app to fly the campus and generate a 3D model. This process is used by civil engineers and surveyors to gather information about existing site conditions before designing proposed projects. Intro to AutoCAD is the first class in Mid-State's Online Civil Drafting Certificate. Students interested in continuing their education in civil engineering design can enroll in the remaining three online classes to complete the certificate while in high school, earning seven college credits that transfer directly into the Civil Engineering program at Mid-State, as well as some four-year engineering programs as elective courses. It's a great way for high school students to see if a career in engineering is right for them.
