
# **Spring Choral Concert**

All questions are multiple choice and will vary across a wide range of subjects and categories. Teams will have a limited amount of time to input their answer and automatic real-time updates and rankings will be shown on the presentation screen to show who's in the lead!

Can teams cheat? This live trivia game experience uses a points timer. Teams that answer questions correctly and the fastest, based on their mad trivia knowledge, are awarded the most points. If a team were to try and cheat by Googling an answer, they will most likely run out of time to input an answer and will not be awarded as many points for their answer. Additionally, each question may be answered only once, and teams cannot change their answer once input.


In addition to the 3 top teams winning prize money, all registered players will be automatically entered into our Trivia Raffle, with the chance to win multiple prizes throughout the event.
